St. George's offers a wide variety of worship opportunities to help all people experience connection with a living, loving God, from a 16th century traditional Eucharist (Rite I) to an evening worship celebration (*The Journey*).



In addition to our two distinctly different services on Sunday mornings (8:00 a.m. traditional Holy Eucharist and 10:30 a.m. Choral Eucharist with Sunday School), we have another on Tuesday mornings at 8:30 a.m., and a contemporary celebration on Sunday evenings at 5:00 p.m.

We have many choirs, and share musical traditions from every age and culture. Holidays (holy days) and other special occasions and rites of passage are magical times at St. George's when the whole community celebrates our connection with God and each other.
